*Out of My Hands*

To see Adam Miller perform live is an experience that reflects the exuberance and vitality of his playing.

Some artists have difficulty transferring this to a recording but this is not the case with Adam. Definitely nothing lost in the translation here!

He does have the luxury on this CD of support musicians Peter Gray on bass guitar and Nic Cecire on drums. These seasoned performers follow, lead and combine with Adam to produce a tight-knit unit that sounds as though they have played together for years!

Adam has written all the songs himself and produced the album. He didn't track record the CD preferring to do it live.

Track 2 - *Traffic*, exhibits just how well the musicians combine on a far from simple number.

*Straight Forward* slows the pace down and the next track *Finding Home* is an even slower number but a very catchy romantic track.

Chris Harley on piano joins Adam on *Frankie* – a most enjoyable number.

But my pick on the album is the final track *All I Need*. It opens with Adam softly playing ukulele then breaking into a lively pace with a great piece of electric bass.

This is a very good album by an accomplished guitarist and supported by top musicians. I hope that he gets the exposure that will bring his talents to a wide portion of the community.
