We round off the first half in June with the simply amazing **Mark Isaacs Resurgence Band**.

"Many of these performers enjoy both national and international acclaim, so it's a real buzz to be able to host such high calibre artists," Rod said.

The broad appeal of the music featured at **dungeon jazz** is, he says, reflected in the audiences. "We present contemporary sounding, sometimes edgy jazz, but first and foremost it is accessible and a great experience. For our audience, age is irrelevant. This is some of the best jazz in Australia, music that speaks to all."
